

# Report from Assembly of Capital Area Council of Churches- Consolidated Report

During the recent Assembly meeting members met in small groups and were invited to address the following question: "As loving and compassionate people of faith, how do we respond to the world around us and what is one thing that we can do together?" Based on the reports from those groups, we recommend forming three focus groups to help guide the work of CACC. The suggested focus groups are as follows:

#### **FOCUS TOPIC: Faith in Action**

FOCUS QUESTION: How can we work together on different topics that restore human connection?

## Suggested ideas:

Continue to address food insecurity, homelessness, economic and health disparities, and community divisions. Streamline our structure to support mission and minimize meetings.

### **FOCUS TOPIC: Proclaiming the Gospel (Clergy group)**

FOCUS QUESTION: How can clergy offer leadership in addressing the physical and spiritual needs of those in the Capitol Region?

#### Suggested ideas:

On a particular day, all clergy offer a sermon on the theme of unity/compassion.

Once a week feature a different pastor's sermon on the CACC website.

Clergy organize prayerful meeting for member churches.

Clergy offer leadership in interfaith dialogue and understanding.

## **FOCUS TOPIC: Diversity and Inclusion**

FOCUS QUESTION: How can CACC offer safe space, sacred ground for the coming together of diverse people and divergent views?

#### Suggested ideas:

Offer opportunities to listen and discover the perspectives of others around us. Train ourselves. Engage with others. Offer listening tours that include diverse members of our congregations and communities.
